

**APPLICATION FOR RESEARCH TRACK, LEON LEVY FELLOWSHIP,

- The **Research Track** offers 14 months of dedicated time for mentored research, compared to 10-11 months of research time permitted in the general adult residency track. In addition, residents have a 2 month experience on a clinical research unit. Any residency applicant with extensive research experience and a commitment to a career in research may apply for the research track.

- The **Leon Levy Resident Fellowship** offers financial support for research and supplemental stipends for residents with substantial research experience, such as receipt of a Ph.D. degree, who wish to pursue research activities that apply the rigors of empirical science to study problems of relevance to the causes, mechanisms and/or treatment of psychiatric disorders.

-The **Moynihan Clinical Research Fellowship** offers financial support for research and supplemental stipends for residents with substantial research experience who wish to pursue patient-oriented clinical research focused on translating advances in neuroscience into transformations in clinical care.
